In 2017, with a 160 year legacy of service in the CSRA, the non-profit Family YMCA of Greater Augusta offered programs and services at 75 CSRA locations including 10 program and wellness facilities, one Child Development Center, and Camp Lakeside, a 100-acre camp located on Lake Thurmond.

The Family Y's Primetime program provided after-school care at 40 Richmond, McDuffie and Aiken County elementary schools and 16 summer camp sites. The Head Start Pre-K Program operated seven facilities in Aiken and Barnwell Counties.

Youth Development

In 2017, we continued to focus on developing youth within the communities we serve. We saw growth in our Primetime program, adding four new locations for before and after-school care to help working parents. More than 420 students were enrolled in our South Carolina Head Start sites. The YMCA's Child Development Center and several of our Primetime schools received Quality Rated distinction. Quality Rated is a systemic approach to assess, improve, and communicate the level of quality in early and school-age care and education programs.

We continued with our venture to feed children while they are out of school through our Summer Food Program/Mobile Food Service we implemented in 2016. Children in the counties we serve were fed nutritious meals during the summer months, averaging over 1,300 meals a day. During the 12-weeks of summer camp, all of our summer camp sites provided free meals to anyone under the age of 18, totaling over 65,000 meals. That's 15,000 more than the previous year.

Healthy Living

This year we launched Les Mills classes in all of our locations, allowing members access to standardize programming across all our venues. Team Lean 2017 saw another great year of participation with more than 900 people participating. Team Lean has been a successful partnership with many area businesses as we're all striving for a healthier workplace.

We awarded more than \$2 Million in scholarships to allow children to participate in youth sports and programming, and allowing family's access to memberships they would not otherwise be able to afford.

Social Responsibility

This year we took on a new initiative to provide children from low-income families with a new bed of their own. With the help of donations from the community and many volunteers from Fort Gordon, area churches and local businesses we have delivered more than 120 beds, bedding, bibles, a stuffed animal, and food through our A Place to Dream program. The program will continue into 2018 with a bed delivery once a month.

Camp Lakeside launched Phase Two of our capital campaign as we continue to secure donations to continue the dream of providing camp for everyone, regardless of their ability level. This phase of construction includes four new cabins, an on-site chapel and a zero-entry pool. Thanks to donations from the Citizens of Georgia Power at Plant Vogtle and the Harvey Langdale Jr. Foundation, a double cabin was completed in 2017.

AIKEN COUNTY FAMILY YMCA

The Aiken County Family YMCA kicked off the first ever Safety Around Water (SAW) Program in 2017. More than 500 participants learned how to have a safe summer around water. The PrimeTime After School program was also expanded from two to five sites providing before and after-school care for working parents to over 300 kids everyday who are learning and thriving.

The Aiken Y also partnered with Great Oak Therapeutic Riding Center to provide scholarships and assistance for kids with physical and mental disabilities to have access to equine therapy. This has been a successful partnership and allowed us to grow our programming.

BARNWELL COUNTY FAMILY YMCA

The Barnwell County Family YMCA introduced three new programs in 2017. One of those programs was LIVESTRONG at the YMCA. This program is offered at most of our YMCAs and promotes the importance of physical activity after cancer diagnosis, and is a support group. The results were overwhelmingly positive and we look forward to continuing this life-changing program.

The Barnwell Y also kicked off Group Cycling classes for the first time. By expanding our fitness offerings, we now have more than 30 classes a week. The Y is also very excited to offer Shag and Beginning Ballroom dancing classes for couples on a monthly basis.

FAMILY YMCA'S CAMP LAKESIDE

In 2017, Camp Lakeside experienced exciting changes! In keeping with our goal to make camp accessible to every child, we added two new buildings to camp. Each will provide access to camp experiences for children with a variety of abilities and needs.

Our new Multipurpose Building features a full commercial kitchen, full size gymnasium with bleachers, a stage and the ability to seat up to 500 people for a variety of programs. This building enabled us to serve hundreds of campers throughout the summer, and to host rental groups from churches and other organizations in our community.

Our brand new Double Cabin is fully handicap accessible, with bathrooms and showers housed inside. It can sleep up to 60 campers. This summer it served dozens of campers during Overnight Camp, and it also provided an example of future cabins to be built at Camp Lakeside. This is only the beginning for Camp Lakeside, with it's overall goal to provide camp for everyone!

FAMILY YMCA'S CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER

Our Child Development Center serves children ages 6 weeks through Pre-K. In 2017 we served 141 students, with 88 percent being scholarship recipients. Our biggest accomplishment of the year was receiving Quality Rated distinction of two stars on December 8, 2017.

The Center hosted United Way and Project Serve Volunteers who cleaned up the garden and planted red, green and yellow bell peppers along with Rosemary. Ripe vegetables are placed at the front desk for families to take home and enjoy.

The Center hosted Augusta University's Day of Service, we had 20 volunteers come and touch up paint in all the classrooms.

MARSHALL FAMILY YMCA

The Marshall Family YMCA increased the number of participants in our LIVESTRONG at the YMCA Program from 36 to more than 50 and added two additional classes to accommodate the growth.

We formed a partnership with Columbia County to exclusively offer Lacrosse in Columbia County to ages 8 to 17. Columbia County provides the space and equipment and the Marshall Family YMCA facilitated the program.

We sponsored a family this holiday season and provided clothes, food and presents!

NORTH AUGUSTA FAMILY YMCA

The North Augusta Family YMCA completed construction on a new CrossFit room. The room was made larger to accommodate class growth and increased participation. The branch got eight new treadmills for the fitness floor. North Augusta also offered new programs in 2017: Mother's Morning Out, and additional Cycle and CrossFit classes. Our afterschool Primetime program added three new schools this school year, from two sites to five sites.

Fundraising events like our annual golf tournament and a Pie in the Face helped raise money for our annual campaign. We also added a Ping-Pong table, foosball table, an arcade basketball game and an adjustable playground for our Child Watch rooms. We held our annual Fall Family Festival that is a FREE community event with lots of family activities.

NORTH JEFFERSON FAMILY YMCA

The North Jefferson Family YMCA added four extra treadmills and two extra ellipticals. We also received a new complete set of free weights. Our afterschool program has increased since we started it about three years ago, from 10 to 40 elementary students. We are having great success with our Senior Activates fitness class, Fit After 50 to Pot Luck's and trips, we took a trip to Lights of the South at Christmas.

We won two Best of Jefferson County awards in 2017, Best Kid's Extracurricular Activity/Program, and Julie Prescott won Best Personal Trainer.

Our group ex classes are increasing in size. Our 6:30 pm classes on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday average around 20 people. We also started a Zumba class this year, which has grown to around 15 participants.

RIVERFRONT YMCA/ DOWNTOWN AUGUSTA FAMILY YMCA

In the Summer of 2017 the Family YMCA of Greater Augusta sold the property at 945 Broad Street, home to the Family YMCA of Greater Augusta Headquarters and home to the Downtown Augusta Family YMCA to Taxslayer. Headquarters was relocated to Claussen Road, and the former Downtown Augusta Family YMCA is now Riverfront YMCA located in the Unysis Building along the Riverwalk.

The new location opened its doors December 26, 2017 and had a Grand Opening/Ribbon Cutting event for the public on January 13, 2018. The new space will allow us to offer unique programming special to the Riverfront property. Programming such as running/biking/walking clubs, Yoga on the Riverwalk, Zumba on the Augusta Common and more are in the works.

The Wellness floor now has treadmills and elipcal machine facing the river, and we now have Espresso Bikes, you can ride anywhere (digitally) in the world.

This year the Steiner Branch Family YMCA implemented a Home School P.E. program in with 32 participants per session.

The branch also continued to grow the Youth Sports program in Grovetown by increasing the number of participants in each sport at various ages and skill levels, and volunteers. Our summer camp programming has also been growing with a day camp partnership with Patriot’s Park.

Several success events this year such as Parents’ Night Out and the Freedom Fun Run helped us raise money for our annual campaign.

THOMSON FAMILY YMCA

The Thomson Family YMCA opened in 2017. The new facility has an outdoor pool, a spin room, a large wellness floor with more equipment and room than the previous space, a suana and steam room, two workout studios and a large dance studio.

New programs were added in 2017. Art Club, instructed by Lisa Rushton, has had a lot of interest. We had our first Art Show in December 2017 in which the kids auctioned off their art to raise money for Annual Campaign.

Hip Hop Dance is another program added, thanks to the addition of the dance studio. Hip Hop Dance was started in August 2017, under the direction of Tony Mims. This class has 12-15 children, and had its first recital in December 2017.

WILSON FAMILY YMCA

Pickleball has been gaining popularity at the Wilson Family since it began in the Summer of 2015. There are now hundreds of players. During Open Play a large crowd enjoys taking turns on our four courts. Pickleball combines elements of tennis, badminton, and ping pong. The nature of the sport encourages interaction between players on and off the court! Pickleball is known as “the friendliest sport on earth.” At the Wilson Family Y, pickleball draws together members who are diverse in every way. People of all ages and all skill levels play together.

Adaptive Personal Training in the new Paul Van Antwerpen and Family Total Access Wellness Center has begun. Personal training sessions for individuals affected by physical or cognitive disabilities using specialized accessible equipment is the only Total Access Wellness Center in the CSRA. Adaptive Trained staff use the specialized accessible fitness equipment to improve participants' balance, range of motion, coordination, core and muscle tone.

FAMILY YMCA PRIMETIME BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Throughout the year we had more than 1,300 students enrolled in four counties and awarded more than \$800,000 in scholarships to students who were in need of financial assistance.

One of our major focuses has been completing the process of becoming “Quality Rated” by the Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning. Since the beginning of the 2017-18 school year five of our Primetime Sites have gained a rating, with a goal of completing all our sites by the end of 2019.

Quality Rated gives our parents and families greater confidence in our Primetime program because independent, credentialed experts in early education have assessed whether programs follow best practices, such as: Employing qualified teachers, providing a safe, healthy and caring environment, implementing individualized instruction, offering a curriculum that prepares children for kindergarten, a focus on both active learning and social/emotional development, and engaging families and providing a low teacher-student ratio.

FAMILY YMCA HEAD START ACADEMY

The Family YMCA Head Start Academy provides a comprehensive child and family development program for qualified children three to age five and their families. In addition to early childhood education, children and families receive health and nutrition services, family development support, access to mental health services, as well as support for children with disabilities.

Our Head Start program serves 427 in Aiken and Barnwell counties and our growth has come by way of an Enrollment Reduction that raised the amount that we receive per student. This allowed us to increase staff pay, purchase additional resources and enhance our Early Learning Program. This school year we are currently at 100% Funded Enrollment for four consecutive months as we prepare for our first of two Federal Reviews during this fiscal year. What a wonderful opportunity this is for us to Shine!

The Riverfront YMCA opened its doors on December 26, 2017. The new facility is located at One 7th Street in Downtown Augusta. This new facility has the best view in Augusta, the Savannah River.

The offical Grand Opening of the branch was January 13, 2018. Although the new location is smaller than the previous location off Broad Street the new space offers so many wonderful opportunities. Some of the progams the Riverfront YMCA would like to offer are: Yoga on the Riverwalk, Zumba on the Augusta Common, runs along the Savannah River/Augusta Canal, and eventually even paddleboard yoga and guided paddles.

The facilty still offers treadmills, which now face the river, eliptical machines, weight machines and some of our most popular classes, but our new location now offers so much more. We now have a free weight station, and outdoor (NEED NAME), Espresso Bikes, which allow riders to digitally ride anywhere in the world.

One of the main focuses of the Riverfront YMCA will be to create and strengthen our corporate partnerships to create a healthier downtown Augusta!

CAMP LAKESIDE/HEALING THROUGH JOY

Fifteen years ago, along the shores of Lake Thurmond, Camp Lakeside was developed to provide day and overnight camps for youth, adults, families and military groups in the Central Savannah River Area (CSRA). A partnership between the Family YMCA of Greater Augusta and the Children’s Hospital of Georgia includes a renovation and expansion that will allow anyone with a chronic health condition or disability to have access to a life-changing camp experience.



Double Cabin Dedicated in 2017

We’re excited to say that **Phase One** of our renovation is complete. Improvements were made to existing facilities such as the archery range, arts and crafts building, and existing cabins and trails. New structures such as a 25,000 Multipurpose Building (completed in 2016) and a double cabin (completed in 2017), thanks to donations from the Citizens of Georgia Power at Plant Vogtle and the Harvey Langdale Jr. Foundation.

We’re excited to say that 2017 marked the beginning of **Phase Two** of our journey to make Camp Lakeside a destination for campers of all walks of life and abilities. The Children’s Hospital of Georgia (Children’s Hospital) has been offering specialized camp programs for children across Georgia facing significant health challenges such as cancer, heart conditions, diabetes and joint disorders. Currently, Children’s Hospital utilizes a camp facility 100 miles from Augusta which poses significant challenges. Camp Lakeside will provide a camp closer to home that will serve more children and families.

Phase Two includes a 5,000 square foot, state-of-the-art, full service medical facility, a 300,000 gallon, zero-entry swimming pool (shallow end of the pool is ground level to provide wheelchair access) with a splash pad, “lazy river” feature, bath house and restroom facilities four new “next generation”, and four cabins that can accommodate up to 30 campers each. To help accomplish Phase Two we began a campaign called Healing Through Joy, a five-year initiative sponsored by the Family YMCA to expand and enhance Camp Lakeside, so that we can provide a memorable camping experience for all children, youth and adults.

The CSRA has many wonderful social service agencies helping low-income families obtain housing, but few help these families turn their housing into functional homes. Consequently, residents are forced to sleep on the floor, air mattresses, sofas, or crowded into a bed with other family members.

Recent studies link poor sleep with cognitive, physical and even behavioral health issues. People who do not get enough quality sleep have poor concentration, weaker immune systems, and an increased risk of obesity, diabetes, hypertension and heart disease.

The Y wants to help eliminate bedlessness in the CSRA. In 2017, with the help of the military, churches and several volunteers we delivered more than 120 bed through our A Place to Dream Program.

Deliveries will be monthly in 2018 and we continue to watch this program grow.
