The YMCA movement is full of givers with an attitude to serve. It was a tough year, but we came together to continue moving forward. Our staff, volunteers, members and advocates played an **essential** role in sustaining the Y and serving our community.

Even in the face of challenge, the Y responded to community needs during the pandemic. We repurposed our staff and facilities to provide vital programs and services. At the onset, we partnered with every major hospital in the CSRA to provide free childcare for healthcare workers, first responders and essential personnel. We also provided shelf-stable groceries, grab-and-go meals, fresh produce boxes, prepared meals and snack bags to families facing food shortages. We continued to provide children without beds free beds through our A Place to Dream program.

As a response to civil unrest in 2020, our staff created a Diversity and Inclusion Committee to ensure that the Y reflects the communities we serve. The YMCA is essential in our mission to develop kids, build healthy communities and encourage everyone to be servants to God and each other. We are an organization that can be counted on when our community needs us. In times of hardship, our movement has proven time and time again that we are essential to those we serve. As a thought leader and best in class provider of education, wellness, youth development and community building, the YMCA of Greater Augusta is one of the oldest, most nimble and essential nonprofits in the CSRA. The history of our organization has been one of adapting to community needs and being there for our neighbors when they need us most.

DURING COVID

Our role pivoted in 2020 during the COVID-19 pandemic to serve our community however we were needed. When our facilities closed for 44 days, we found ways to keep members engaged and provided support for our friends and neighbors.

From expanding our Food Program to offering virtual activities, the Y has used every resource at our disposal to ensure the continued health and safety of our community. Our staff have worked diligently to maintain clean, sanitary spaces for members and program participants to enjoy.

The COVID-19 pandemic was an opportunity for the Y to serve the Greater Augusta region like never before. We were able to push the limits of our organization's adaptability to find the best ways to help those in need.

2021 & BEYOND

Going forward, we will continue providing health & wellness resources to all. We will develop more virtual programs, and continue offering unlimited virtual group exercise classes. Our strict cleaning procedures will remain the standard in all of our Ys.

YMCA membership will always be more than access to a gym. Beyond the pandemic, individuals, children and families will still need the Y's programs and services. Our Signature Programs will continue providing vital resources to our neighbors.

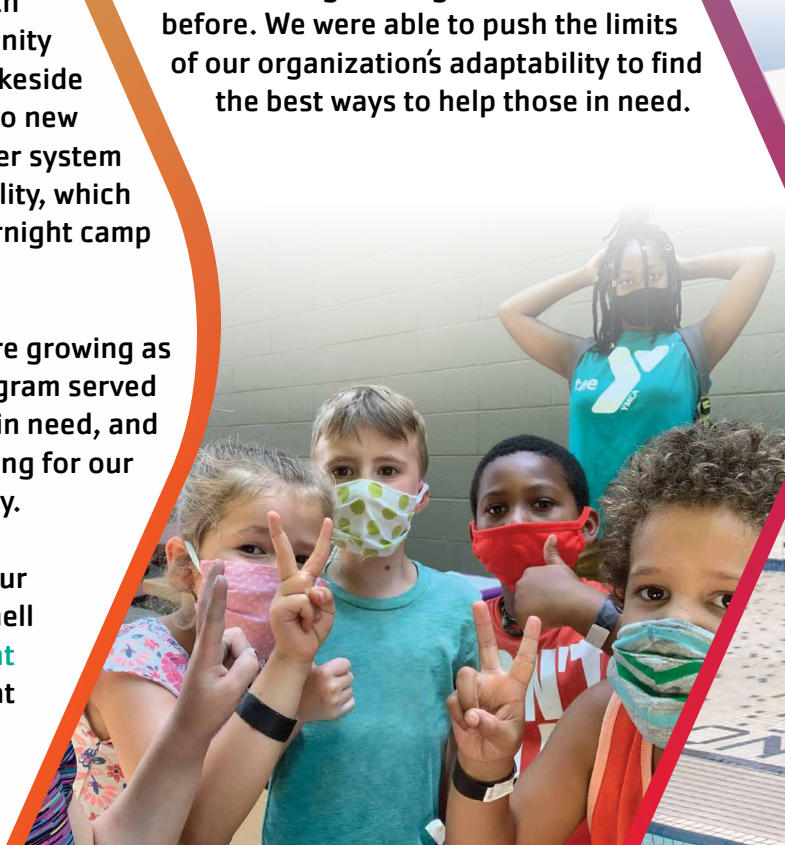
The Y will always be there for our community when they need us.

IN 2019

In 2019, we were focused on growth and development. We opened the Burke County Family YMCA in June 2019, which brought together a new community under the Y's mission. Camp Lakeside completed construction on two new cabins, an improved wastewater system and a renovated medical facility, which allows us to expand our overnight camp capabilities.

Our Signature Programs were growing as well. The Summer Food Program served 119,000 meals to individuals in need, and A Place to Dream was preparing for our thousandth bed delivery.

In our 2019 Annual Report, our President & CEO Danny McConnell wrote, "It's our adaptability that keeps our mission moving." That was even more evident in 2020.





FOREVER NURTURING

Each year, the Y works to provide engaging activities for children in a caring and safe environment, and this year was no different. While adults dealt with the COVID-19 pandemic and civil unrest, our children still required safe spaces where they could grow and be cared for.

Throughout the crisis, we looked for ways to best serve children in our community. We adapted so we could continue to nurture our youngest members – especially as they adjusted to the many changes related to COVID-19.

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS IN REVIEW

- At the onset of the pandemic, we provided **free childcare to essential personnel** at four of our locations.
- When our branches reopened to members, we began offering **summer day camp** so children had somewhere to go while their parents worked.
- During the school year, the Y worked with all area school districts to execute **Prime Time Before and After School** childcare in a safe environment.
- When schools transitioned to remote learning, we stepped in to fill the void by offering **Virtual Learning Camps** at our branches.
- Throughout the pandemic, we offered enriching youth programs with health and safety guidelines in place, like **Youth Sports, Parents' Night Out, School Days Out** and **holiday camps**.

The Y will always be a safe place for learning and growth; we will always offer programs that ensure all children have the opportunity to learn new skills; and we will always be an organization dedicated to helping kids reach their full potential.

AIKEN COUNTY FAMILY YMCA

Aiken County Family YMCA found ways to serve children during the COVID-19 pandemic. When our doors were forced to close, we provided FREE childcare for Essential Personnel. Throughout the summer, we safely held Summer Day Camp for more than **500 children**.



FAMILY YMCA YOUTH DEVELOPMENT BRANCH

The YMCA Youth Development Branch maintained constant communication with area school districts to ensure we were meeting the needs of parents. From Prime Time After School to Virtual Learning Camps to School Days Out, we have served **more than 1,100 children** throughout the school year.



NORTH AUGUSTA FAMILY YMCA

The North Augusta Family YMCA was one of the first branches to offer Essential Personnel childcare during our COVID-19 shutdown. The program was consistently full, with **24 children every day**. Working parents received special appreciation from community partners like Ladybug Flowers and Two Moms Kitchen.



STEINER BRANCH FAMILY YMCA

Steiner Branch Family YMCA supported Columbia County parents during the school year by offering programs like Summer Camp, Virtual Learning Camp, Parent's Night Out, School Days Out and Prime Time After School. This year, we have had **more than 400 children** in our care.



FAMILY YMCA CHILD DEVELOPMENT ACADEMY

After losing funding, the Child Development Academy was forced to close during the COVID pandemic. Thanks to the generosity of University Hospital, we were able to remodel the building during the summer and fall of 2020. We reopened January 4, 2021 to serve Augusta's downtown community!



WILSON FAMILY YMCA

In the fall of 2020, Wilson Family YMCA provided Prime Time After School to **more than 35 students every week**. When Richmond County schools transitioned to remote learning, we quickly mobilized to offer a Virtual Learning Camp so parents knew their child was in a safe place.

FOREVER THRIVING

During a year like no other, one thing that remained consistent was our member's desire to focus on their health and wellness. From socially distanced programs to virtual offerings, our staff found creative ways to keep our members thriving while adhering to COVID-19 safety precautions and guidelines.

HEALTHY LIVING PROGRAMS IN REVIEW

- Throughout 2020, we offered programs to help our members get back on track with their fitness including **Maintain Don't Gain**, **YWFL** and **Team Lean Back on Track**.
- Members were motivated to try **Personal Training** as they returned to the gym.
- In-person **Group Exercise Classes** were spaced to safely accommodate the maximum number of participants.
- While **LIVESTRONG® At the YMCA** was paused, our instructor didn't hesitate to create videos with general information and basic stretching for participants.
- Virtual **Bible Studies** were held weekly and shared on our YouTube page for anyone to watch to maintain a healthy spirit.

Providing programs that help members maintain a healthy lifestyle will always be a top priority for the Y. We will always be a place where anyone, no matter their fitness level or age, can come to reach their fitness goals. We will always nurture a healthy mind, body and spirit for everyone who enters our doors.

FOREVER CONNECTED

When our world moved online, the Y did too. In September, we created **Virtual YMCA** so members could continue connecting with us when they couldn't come in person. Y members are now able to take their favorite group exercise classes live on Zoom and have access to an online database of class recordings. Our virtual platform also includes online family activities, virtual personal training, a virtual spiritual center and online chronic disease support resources.

AUGUSTA SOUTH FAMILY YMCA

Augusta South Family YMCA was the birthplace of our Virtual YMCA. Our instructors and staff spearheaded the trials before rolling it out to other YMCA locations. We have had **more than 600** virtual group exercise classes since September 2020.

BARNWELL COUNTY FAMILY YMCA

Barnwell County Family YMCA ended 2020 with their 6th Annual Reindeer Run. **51 runners** came out for the race, which supports our Annual Campaign.

We also welcomed new classes at our branch, like Stretch & Relax.



RIVERFRONT YMCA

At Riverfront YMCA, we made use of our outdoor patio through the COVID pandemic to maximize social distancing. We held **6 spin classes per week** on the patio.

The patio also allowed social distancing for events, like our Patio Prayer in June 2020.

NORTH JEFFERSON FAMILY YMCA

In 2020, North Jefferson Family YMCA hosted a Virtual Run Series with **13 virtual events**. These runs provided members a challenge while allowing social distancing. Proceeds from the events benefited our Annual Campaign. Medals from the virtual runs were created by students of Jefferson County Middle School!

FOREVER IN SERVICE

In great hardship, our Y stood strong to be there for our community. The COVID-19 pandemic was an opportunity for us to truly deliver on our promise to serve everyone around us.

We temporarily closed our doors for 44 days in 2020 and shifted gears to support our neighbors like never before. Even when our facilities reopened, we continued our efforts to fulfill the needs of our community.

SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY PROGRAMS IN REVIEW

- **Cheryl's Kitchen Food Program** provided meals, snacks and fresh produce to families and individuals through partnerships with USDA, Golden Harvest Food Bank, Georgia Grown and World Central Kitchen.
- After our milestone 1,000 bed delivery in January, our **A Place to Dream** bed program had small, emergency deliveries during the pandemic.
- We continued to provide **Financial Assistance** for YMCA membership and programs so no one was turned away for their inability to pay.

At the Y, we are always about bringing people together. When coming together wasn't an option, we still found ways to offer a helping hand to those in need. Generous donors and sustained memberships allow us to continue critical programs to serve children, families and individuals.



FOREVER NOURISHING

In March 2020, as the country began to shut down due to COVID-19, food insecurity rates across the country skyrocketed. When local schools closed, we quickly mobilized to ensure children had access to nutritious meals. Our mobile sites delivered free meals directly to the communities where they were needed, including our first mobile site in McDuffie County.

Free meals were given from the Y to many local organizations so they could be dispersed to those who needed them most. Organizations like Lincoln County Board of Education, GLM2, Thomson Housing Authority and Springfield Baptist Church were instrumental in keeping the CSRA fed through the pandemic.

FOR SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY ACROSS THE ASSOCIATION



BURKE COUNTY FAMILY YMCA

In March 2020, Burke County Family YMCA partnered with Project Linus to create no-sew blankets for our A Place to Dream bed program. Members donated felt and fabric, and volunteers created **more than 20 blankets** for children in need.



THOMSON FAMILY YMCA

Thomson Family YMCA partners with Thomson Rotary Club and other local companies to help deliver beds to children in need through A Place to Dream. Over the past two years, we have provided beds to **71 local families**. Even though we were unable to gather large numbers of volunteers in 2020, we were able to do small, emergency deliveries as needed.



FAMILY YMCA CAMP LAKESIDE

This year, Camp Lakeside had the opportunity to serve Lincoln County through partnerships with Lincoln County Board of Education. Camp staff ensured students were fed by delivering **150 Blessing Bags** every other Friday to Lincoln County BOE for students in need.



FAMILY YMCA TEAM HEADQUARTERS

When the COVID-19 pandemic began, food insecurity rates rose and our Team Headquarters became the center for Cheryl's Kitchen Food Program. Every empty office or unused conference room became food storage or a prep area for Blessing Bags.

We delivered meals to our YMCA branches, community organizations, local churches and neighborhoods. To date, our food program has provided **more than one million** meals to children and individuals in need.

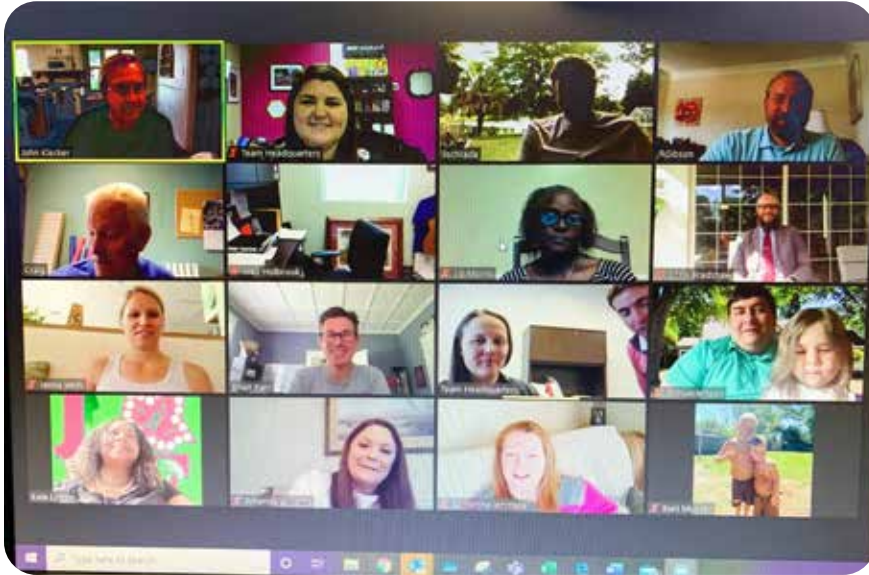

FOREVER ADAPTING

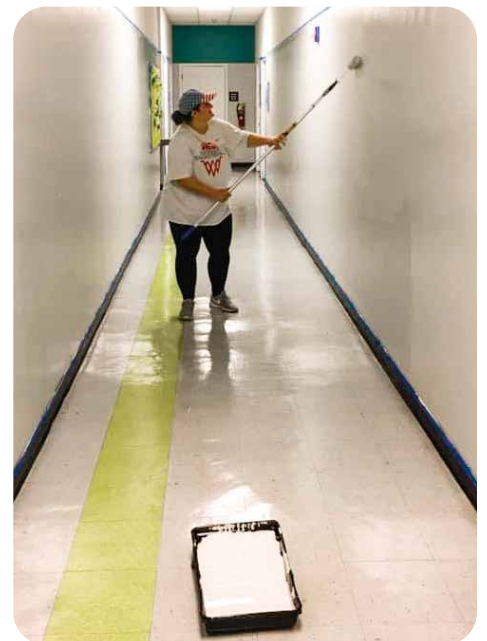

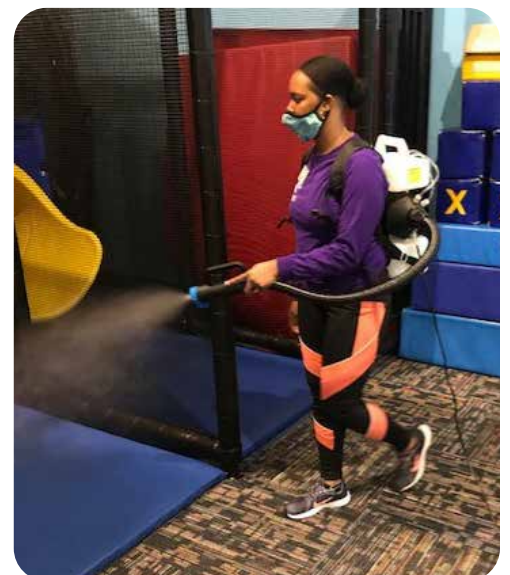
