Youth Development



PRIME TIME AFTERSCHOOL

Prime Time Afterschool provides students with a safe, supportive place to learn and grow beyond the school day. Through homework help, academic enrichment, physical activity and engaging games, children build skills, confidence and friendships while working families gain dependable afterschool care.



SAFETY AROUND WATER

Safety Around Water teaches children essential skills that help them feel confident and stay safe in and around water. Offered at no cost, the program combines land-based instruction with guided water activities to help children recognize risks, respond to emergencies and reduce their risk of drowning.



CAMP I.V.E.Y.

Camp I.V.E.Y. gives children and teens with developmental disabilities an inclusive, week-long overnight camp experience designed to build independence and confidence. Campers form friendships while enjoying traditions such as arts and crafts, archery, fishing, swimming and canoeing in a supportive environment.

Healthy Living



EXCEPTIONAL SPORTS

Exceptional Sports gives children, teens and young adults with physical or developmental disabilities the opportunity to experience team sports in a welcoming, noncompetitive environment. Each athlete is paired with a volunteer buddy who provides encouragement and support as they build skills, confidence and friendships through play.



KATIE'S POOL

The Kathryn M. York Adapted Aquatics Center (Katie's Pool), provides an accessible environment for individuals with disabilities to participate in aquatic therapy and rehabilitation. Specialized features accommodate a variety of mobility needs, helping participants improve movement, build strength and experience greater independence in the water.



LIVESTRONG® AT THE YMCA

LIVESTRONG® at the YMCA helps adults affected by cancer rebuild strength, improve physical fitness and regain confidence during and after treatment. This evidence-based program offers personalized exercise and a supportive community, helping participants manage treatment-related side effects, form meaningful connections and improve their overall quality of life.

Social Responsibility



CHERYL'S KITCHEN

Cheryl's Kitchen Food Program helps address food insecurity by providing nourishing meals to children, individuals and families in need. Through mobile distribution sites and food pantries located within YMCA branches, the program brings reliable food assistance directly to neighborhoods throughout the Greater Augusta community.



A PLACE TO DREAM

A Place to Dream gives children without safe, comfortable sleeping arrangements a bed of their own. Families receive beds, linens, Bibles and stuffed animals, while infants receive playpen cribs. With help from volunteers, children can enjoy the security, comfort and restorative sleep they need to thrive.



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The YMCA's Financial Assistance Program ensures that cost is not a barrier to belonging, learning or growing at the Y. Need-based assistance helps individuals and families access YMCA membership, childcare, camps, youth sports, swim lessons and other programs that strengthen their health, well-being and connection to the community.

Helped **3,900** children and adults build confidence around water through swim lessons and essential water safety education.

Served **650,000** nourishing meals to children and families experiencing food insecurity through Cheryl's Kitchen.

Created adventure, friendships and lifelong memories for **8,119** young people through YMCA Summer Day Camp and Camp Lakeside.

Supported the academic growth and wellbeing of **1,921** students every week through YMCA Afterschool programs at **42** sites.

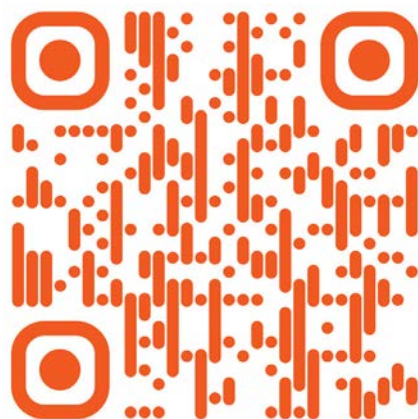
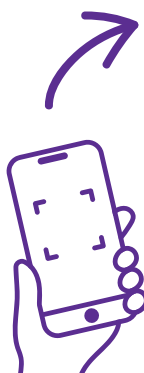
